Children will observe how the seasons change across the year and explore how these changes affect the world around them. They will use their senses to notice and talk about the weather, plants, animals, and other natural features in their environment.

Growing



Children will begin to understand how they grow and change over time, developing awareness of their own personal development. They will also learn to care for living things by helping to look after plants in the garden, discovering what plants need to grow and thrive.

Festivals and Celebrations

Children will explore a range of festivals and celebrations throughout the calendar year, developing an understanding of their own cultural traditions as well as those of others. Through stories, music, food, and creative activities, they will begin to appreciate and respect the diversity of people and communities around them.






Learning Overview

The children will learn about what plants need to grow. They will gain hands-on experience by growing a plant from seed and helping with the general upkeep of the nursery garden. Additionally, the children will learn to identify the different parts of a plant.

Children will explore the roles of everyday heroes within their local community, such as firefighters, police officers, healthcare workers, and others who help keep us safe and well. Through meaningful, hands-on experiences and real-life encounters, children will develop an understanding of how these individuals contribute to our lives. Opportunities for imaginative play, storytelling, and role-play will bring learning to life, helping children make connections between their experiences and the world around them.





