Where to Buy

Uniform Requirements

Reception to Year 2

- Plain white shirt, blouse, or polo shirt (long or short sleeved)
 - Black trousers / black knee-length skirt / black pinafore / black shorts
 - Green and white striped or checked summer dress (*optional for warmer weather*)
 - Black V-neck logo sweatshirt or logo cardigan
 - Plain black shoes (*no trainers or plimsolls*)

Year 3 to Year 6

- Plain white shirt or blouse (long or short sleeved)
 - School tie
 - Black trousers / black knee-length skirt / black pinafore / black shorts
 - Green and white striped or checked summer dress (*optional for warmer weather*)
 - Black V-neck logo sweatshirt or logo cardigan
 - Plain black shoes (*no trainers or plimsolls*)
 - **Leavers hoodie** – Year 6 only

PE Kit – All Year Groups

- Black shorts, sports leggings, or tracksuit bottoms (in colder weather)
- Green polo shirt
- Black sweatshirt or school hoodie (*optional*)
- Trainers or plimsolls
- **Long hair must be tied back** for all PE lessons
- **No jewellery** should be worn during PE lessons

General Expectations – All Children

At Woodlands Primary Academy, we aim to ensure that our uniform policy supports inclusion, safety, and pride in our school community. Please note the following:

- **Reasonable Adjustments:** For children with sensory needs, adjustments can be made in consultation with the child and their parents/carers.
- **Footwear in Winter:** If boots are worn to school in winter, children must change into plain black shoes once inside.
- **Earrings:** Only small, plain stud earrings are permitted (e.g., the first pair worn after ear piercing). These must be removed or covered for PE.
- **Other Jewellery:** No other jewellery should be worn, including rings, bracelets, or necklaces.
- **Make-up and Nails:** Children must not wear make-up, nail varnish, or acrylic nails.
- **Hair:** Dyed hair and extreme hairstyles are not permitted, to ensure equity for all families.
- **Cultural and Faith-Based Hairstyles:** We respect and celebrate all cultures and religions. Children may have their hair styled or covered in accordance with their cultural or religious background.
