Dear parents / carers.

I am sure you will all understand that this is a very difficult time, and, as a school, it is vital that we follow the latest guidance to ensure we keep our children and staff safe.

It is with regret that we will have to alter our plans for the end of year 6. We have received more guidance from Norfolk County that says we cannot have gatherings of over 30 people. They are aware schools may be planning some events and want to clarify the law. We are allowed to have several bubbles in the same area of the school, on the field for example, as long as they are separated. This means we can go ahead with the celebration assembly with the children but will not be able to have any adults there. We will, however film the assembly and post it on Dojo as soon as we are able. We also invite you to come on to the field at 2.45 to collect your child and have the opportunity for photos with their teachers and friends.

We are also moving the disco to during the school day. We will still be having a DJ, games, competitions between bubbles and pizza. The disco will be between 1pm – 3pm. The children can bring in a change of clothes and any accessories they need – I hear there are some themes going on in the bubbles! Again, parents are welcome to join the children at 3pm for photo opportunities.

On the last day, Miss Liddiment has organised for the year 6 pupils to have time on inflatables. There are four year 6 bubbles, so there will be four activities. The company have agreed to disinfect all the activities between uses so we can rotate the bubbles in order for them to have a go on each activity. If you wish, your child can wear gloves / face masks for this activity, we will have some available at school. If you do not want your child to take part, please let Miss Barnes know on Dojo. This is starting at 2pm and will finish at 4pm. You are welcome to join the children on the field from 3pm, remembering social distancing guidelines.

I know some of you may have booked time off from work, and can only apologise for this necessary change. We are trying to make the end of year 6 as special as we can whilst still keeping the children safe.
