

Music intent

Learning to learn	Our learning in music follows the aims and attainment targets set out in the National Curriculum. Our children will be given the opportunity to listen to a wide range of music from various periods of history. We will teach our children about the elements of music and teach them to recognise the instruments they hear and the ways in which they can be combined.
Integration and application	Within music lessons, children will listen and appraise music, learn about the elements of music through practical activities, learn to play a variety of instruments and combine their playing with other children in varied groups. They will be given the chance to explore a vast array of instruments across FS, KS1 and KS2 and perform both in class and to an outside audience.
Understanding and caring for the world around us	In learning music from many areas of the world, the children also learn about the civilisations and people from those areas. Learning about the varied styles from countries and regions will give the children a good understanding of differences between the instrumentation and structure. They will also develop the confidence to critique music and to explain their reasoning behind their thoughts.
