




# Topic Plan

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Ask simple Geographical questions.</li> <li>Talk, draw or write about aspects of the past.</li> <li>Use and explore a variety of tools and techniques to create artwork.</li> <li>Select and use a range of tools to connect materials.</li> <li>Describe, compare and identify a variety of animals.</li> <li>Group animals according to characteristics, including what they eat.</li> <li>Observe the changes across the four seasons including the weather.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Animals fall into five categories - mammals, reptiles, fish, birds and amphibians.</li> <li>Animals can be grouped according to what they eat - herbivores, carnivores and omnivores.</li> <li>Animals are structured in different ways which help them survive around the world.</li> <li>There are four seasons.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Category</b>-a group of animals with shared characteristics.</li> <li><b>Herbivore</b>-plant eater</li> <li><b>Carnivore</b>-meat eater</li> <li><b>Omnivore</b>-eats plants and meat.</li> <li><b>Characteristic</b>-a feature/part of something</li> <li><b>Seasons</b>- four divisions of the year, marked by different weather patterns and daylight hours.</li> </ul>
