Uniform requirements

Reception to Year 2

- Plain white shirt, blouse or polo shirt (long or short sleeved)
- Black trousers/black knee length skirt/black pinafore/Black shorts/green and white striped or checked summer dress
- Black v neck logo sweatshirt or logo cardigan
- School hoodie (optional)
- Plain black shoes (no trainers or plimsoles)

Year 3 to Year 6

- Plain white shirt or blouse (long or short sleeved)
- Tie
- Black trousers/black knee length skirt/black pinafore/Black shorts/green and white striped or checked summer dress
- Black v neck logo sweatshirt or logo cardigan
- School hoodie (optional)
- Leavers hoodie Yr 6 only
- Plain black shoes (no trainers or plimsoles)

Clothing for PE

- Black shorts / tracksuit bottoms in winter (no leggings)
- Plain white T-shirt / plain white T-shirt with house colour neck and sleeve band
- Black sweatshirt or school hoodie (optional)
- Trainers or plimsoles

All Children

- In winter if boots are worn from home, children must change into shoes in school
- it is compulsory for all children to wear a swimming hat during swimming lessons
- Long hair should be tied up, with a hairband or small dark green bow.
- Small plain stud earrings are allowed (a good example is the first pair of earrings when ears are pierced)
