

Homework for Year 3 – Spring 2 2023 WEEKLY HOMEWORK

Here is a list of the homework for you to do each week:

- Daily reading – 10 mins a day on a book of your choice. Please make sure the children ask to complete a test on their book when they are ready so that they can move through the Accelerated Reader scheme at an appropriate speed.
- Weekly times tables – these will be worked on every day in morning activities (current tables as well as the tables we have already looked at). Please practise the set tables remembering that multiplication and division facts will be tested (e.g. $2 \times 5 = 10$ and $10 \div 5 = 2$). 6x table and 9x table this term please!
- Times Tables Rockstars! Some of the games will test the pupils on the set tables for the term while other games will test them on all the times tables.
- Use Spelling Shed to learn and use the spellings for the week. Play the games and build up knowledge of the sounds used in the words. Try to beat your score each time you play the games!

These are the maths skills for this half-term – please practise these when you can.

- Introduction to fractions – simple halves, quarters and thirds.
- Numerators and denominators of fractions – what they mean.
- Mass and capacity – g, kg, l, ml
